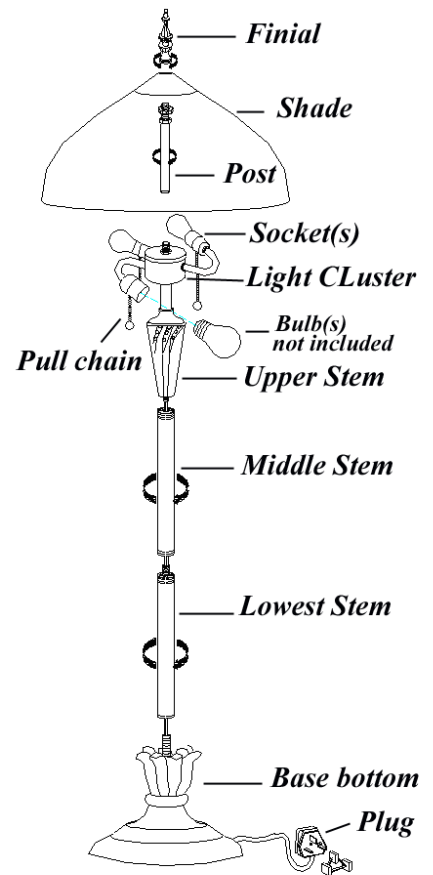


INSTRUCTION MANUAL

INSTALLATION:

Please note that during assembly, the sections of the base's column should be screwed together in such a way that the cable is not twisted more than 360 degrees.

1. Lay all parts of your Floor Lamp out on the floor (if on wooden floor, be sure to lay a towel on the floor first, to prevent scratching).
2. Thread the Lowest stem into the foot of the base.
3. Thread the Middle and Upper stems to the lower stem, gently pulling the power cord at the Floor Lamp's base from time to time, to eliminate any "slack" between the stems.
4. Stand the Base upright and tighten all connecting points (i.e. Base Foot & Stems).
5. Thread the Light Cluster unit onto the Upper stem.
6. Place the threaded post on top of the Cluster.
7. Step back and check the Base to assure that it is straight. If it leans to one side, check to make sure that all stems are secure. If it needs further straightening, place your foot on the base and gently pull the stems towards you. Check the Base again and repeat Step (7) if necessary.
8. Remove the Finial from the post & place the shade (already cleaned per the instructions above) on the Post (the shade should rest on the adjustable "spacer" on the Post).
9. Screw the finial back onto the post.
10. Install light bulbs into the sockets according to the Max. Wattage indicated on the label.
11. Insert the Plug into the wall, use Pull Chain switch to turn on the lamp.

WARNING:

1. If the cable is damaged, do not use the lamp. For repair, take the lamp to a certified electrical framework shop.
2. If your lamp remains turned on for a prolonged time, the lamp shade (glass, cap, bulb, etc.) will become hot and can lead to burns if touched. Let the shade cool somewhat, and test it carefully before handling it.
3. When installing or replacing bulbs, be sure that the Lamp is not plugged into the wall outlet.
4. **If you choose to turn/rotate the shade while it is on the base, do so only in a Clockwise direction, to prevent loosening of the Post.**
5. This lamp is for indoor use only.

CLEANING & CARE: To clean the shade, remove dust with either a paper towel or a duster—no household cleaners are needed. Occasionally, a white powder may appear on the soldering, as a result of Oxidation. To restore the soldering to its original condition, apply a small amount of Lemon or Mineral Oil to the affected area. Remove the oil with a paper towel, as described above. Do not use chemical cleaner.
